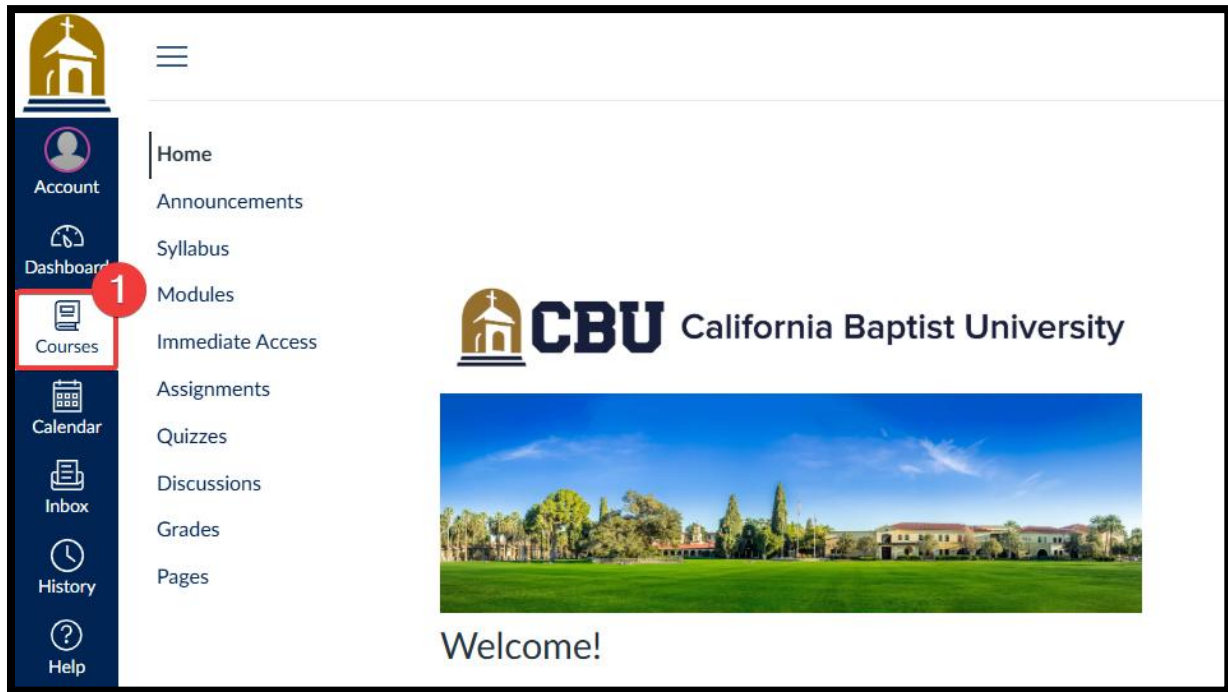

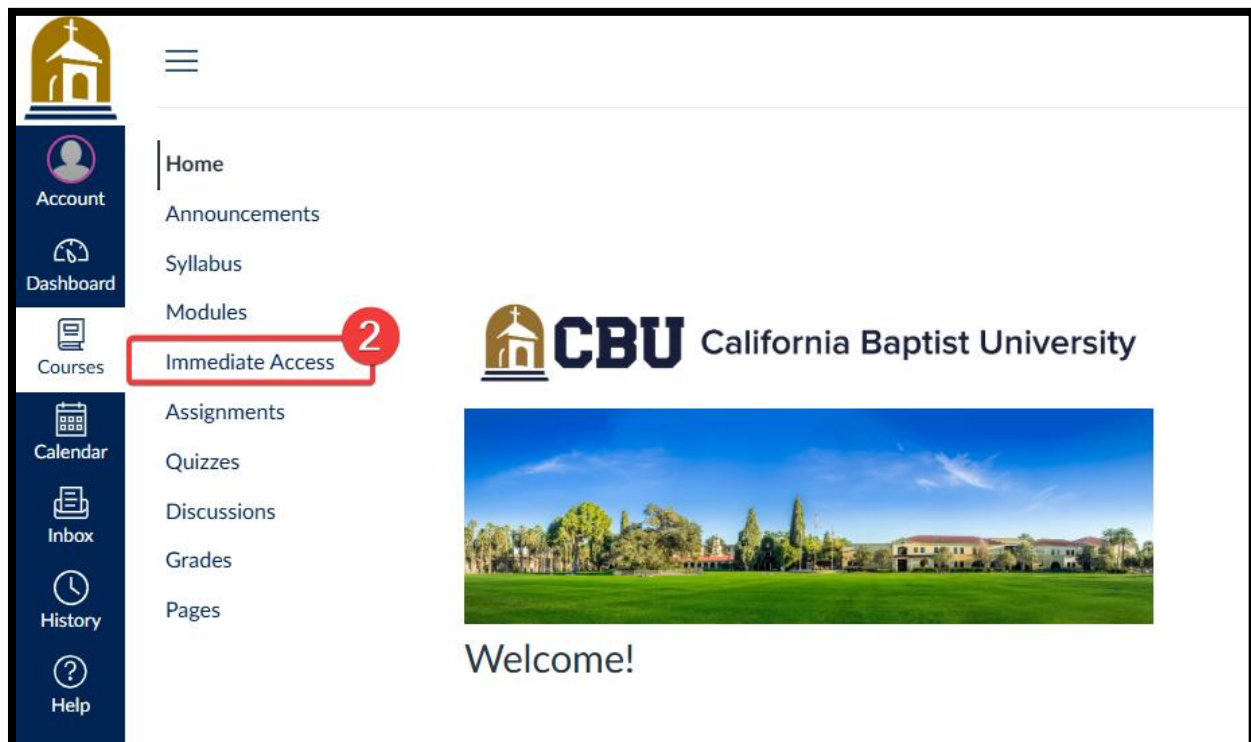

How To Access Pearson MyLab – Mastering or Modified Courseware

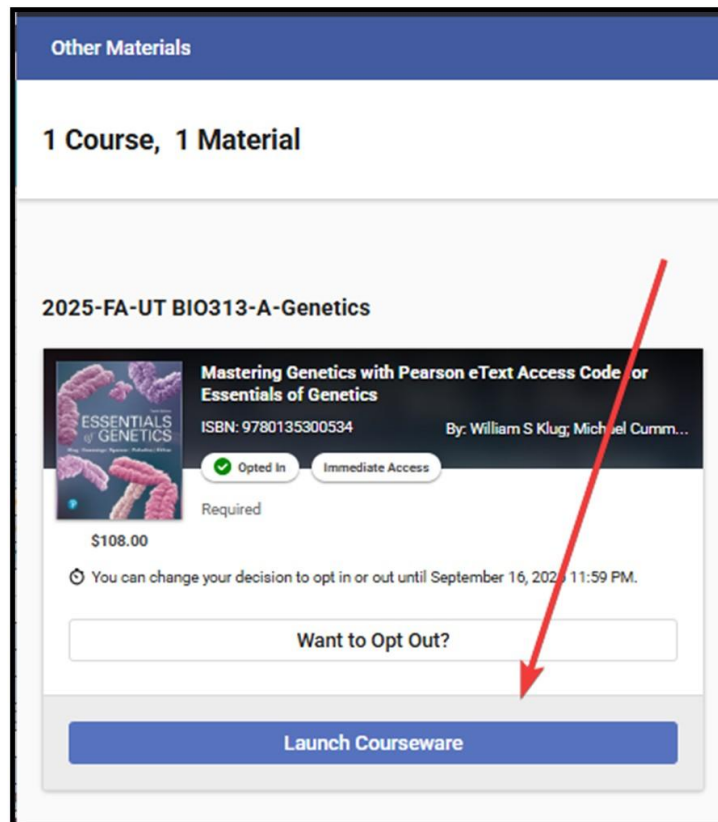
1. In the **Canvas course page** using Pearson MyLab – Mastering or Modified Courseware.



2. Click → **Immediate Access**, from the left hand-side course menu.

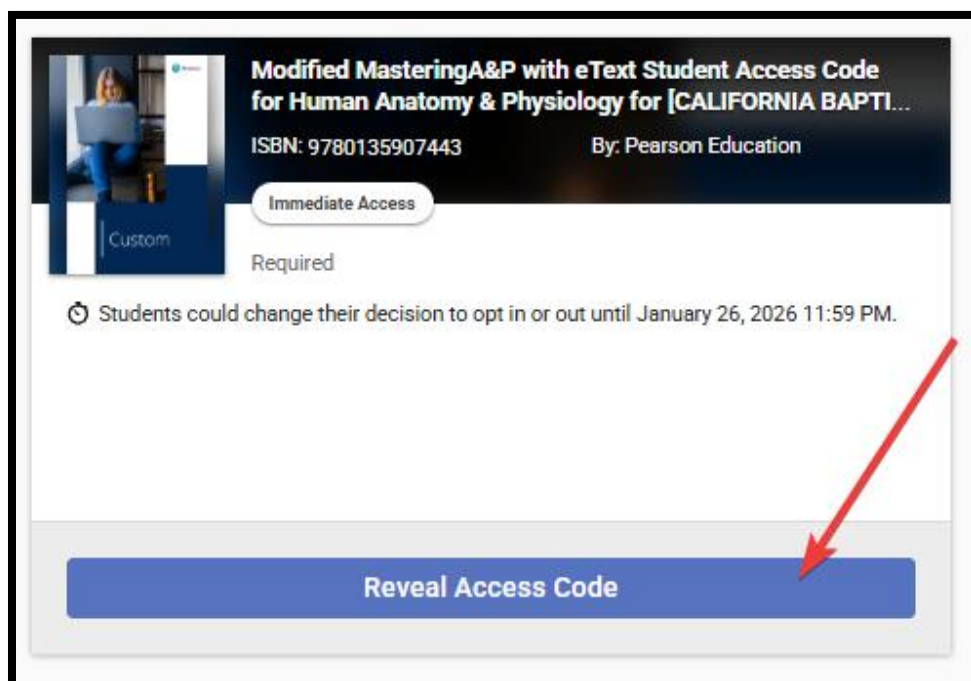


3. Your Pearson title will appear on the right-hand side of the screen. Click → **Launch Courseware** and skip to Step 5.

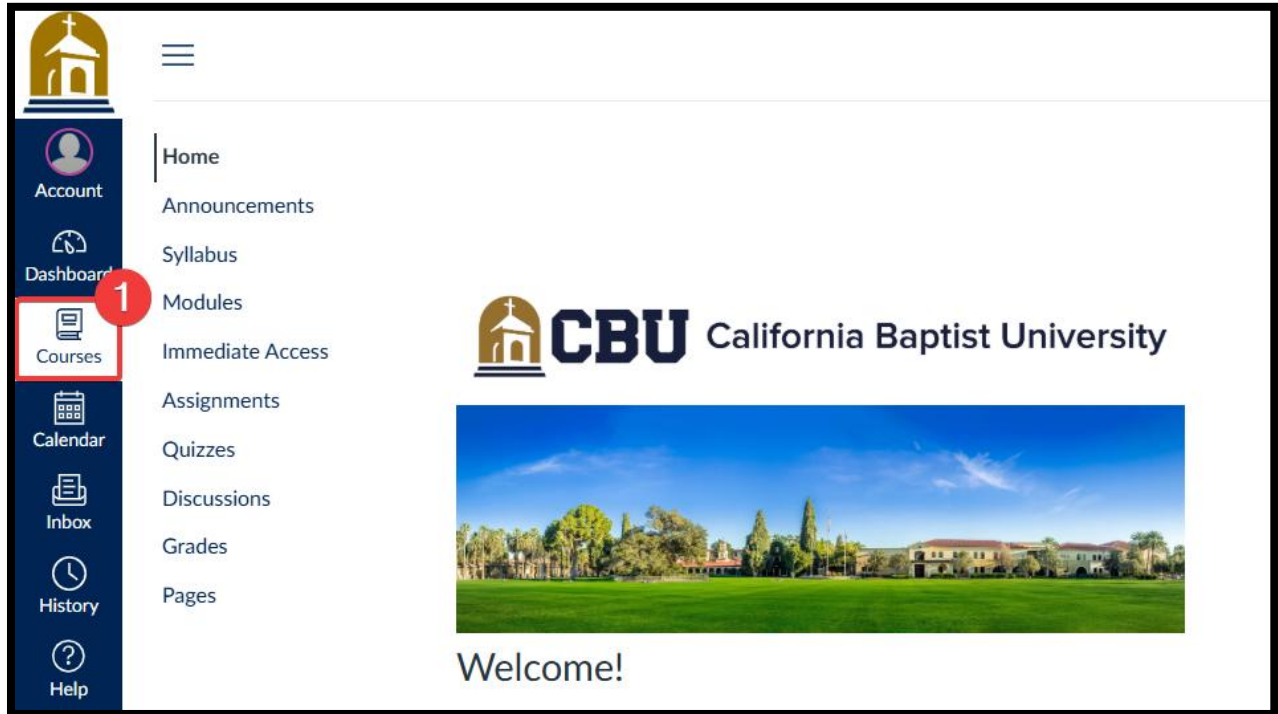

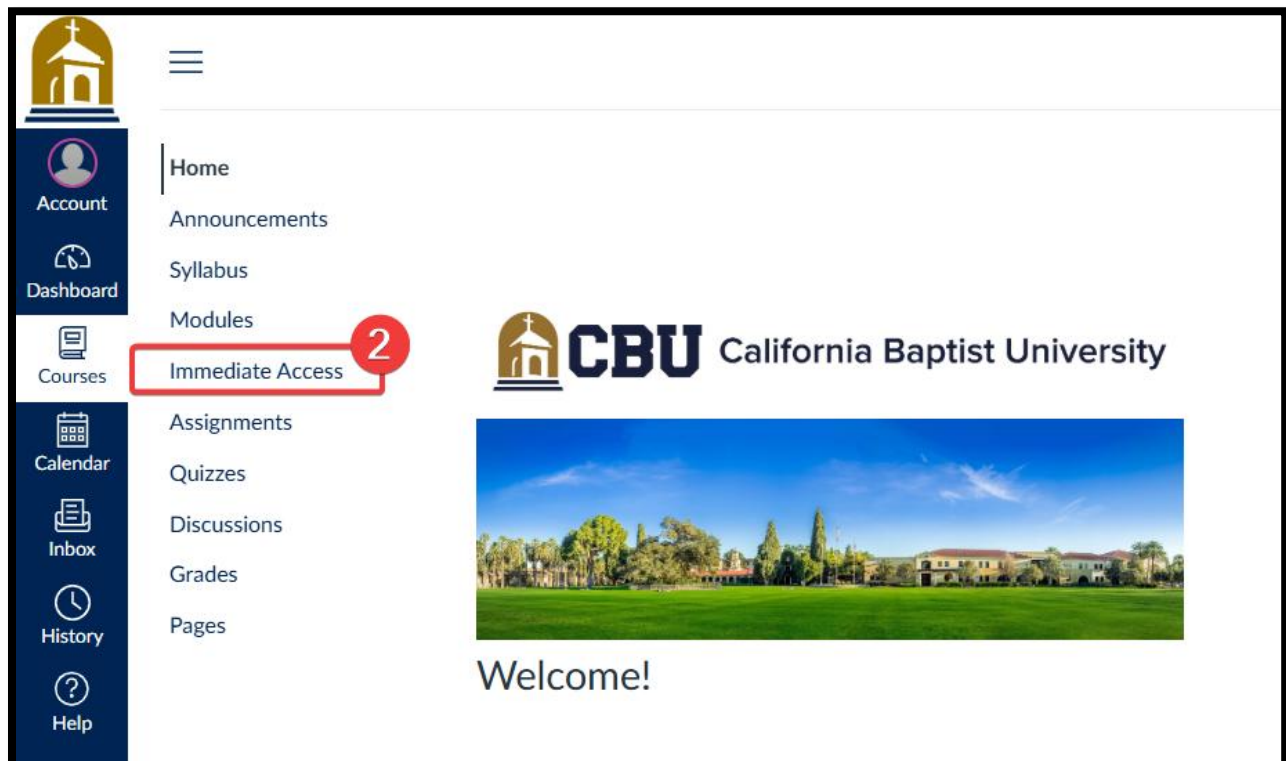


How To Access Cengage MindTap or CNowV2 Courseware

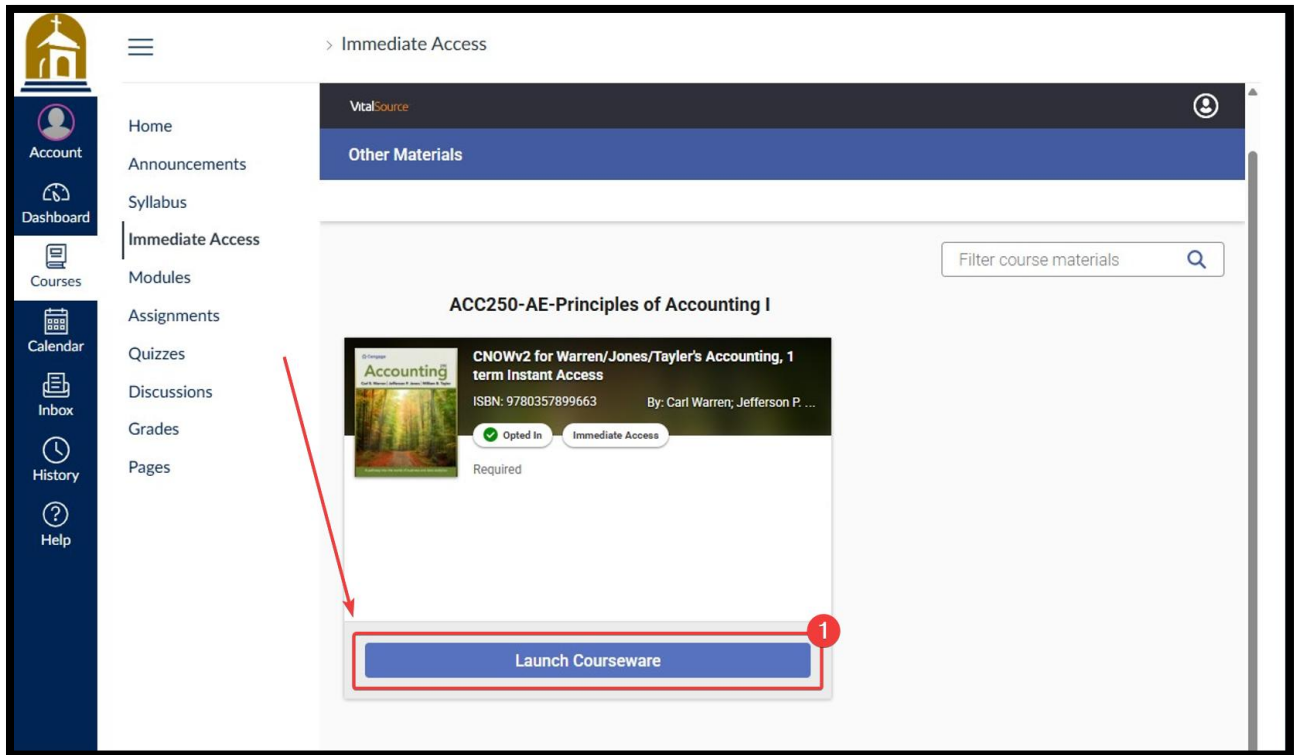
1. Sign onto **Canvas** and go to the course using Cengage MindTap/CNowV2.



2. Click the → **Immediate Access** link on the left-hand side course menu.



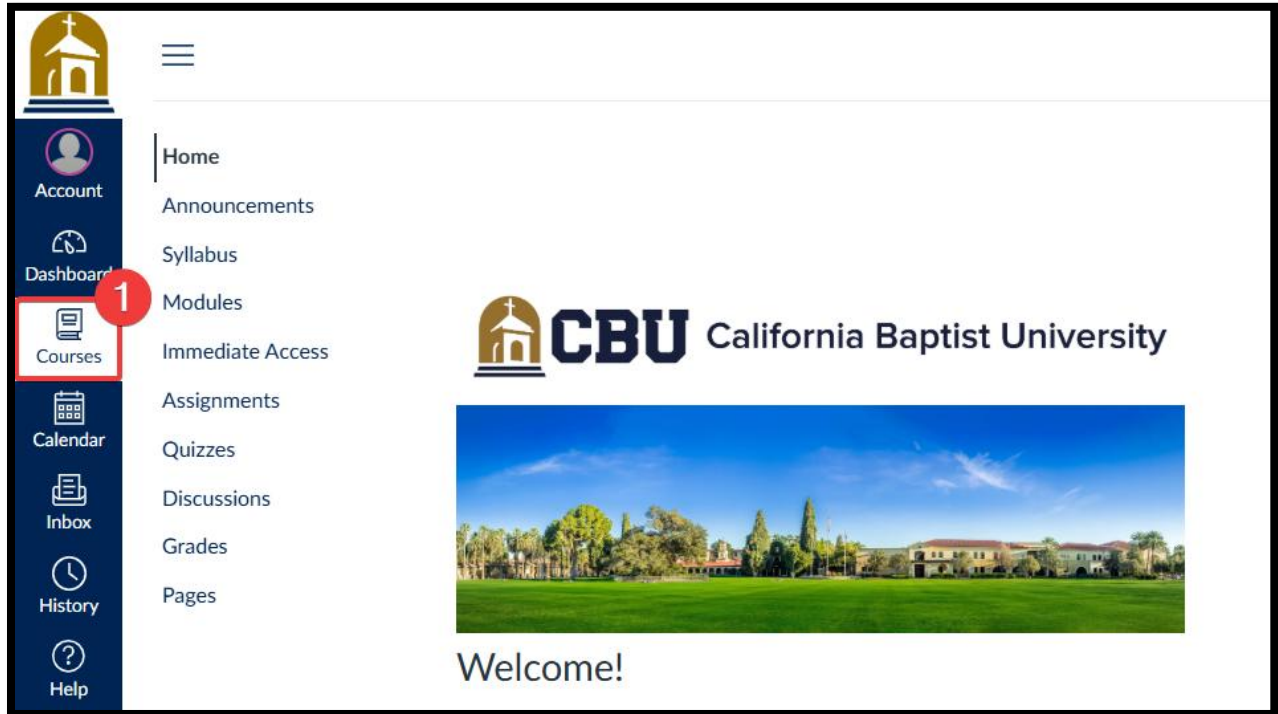
3. On the right-hand side, the Cengage MindTap/CNowV2 material should appear with an option to 'Launch Courseware'. Click → **Launch Courseware**.



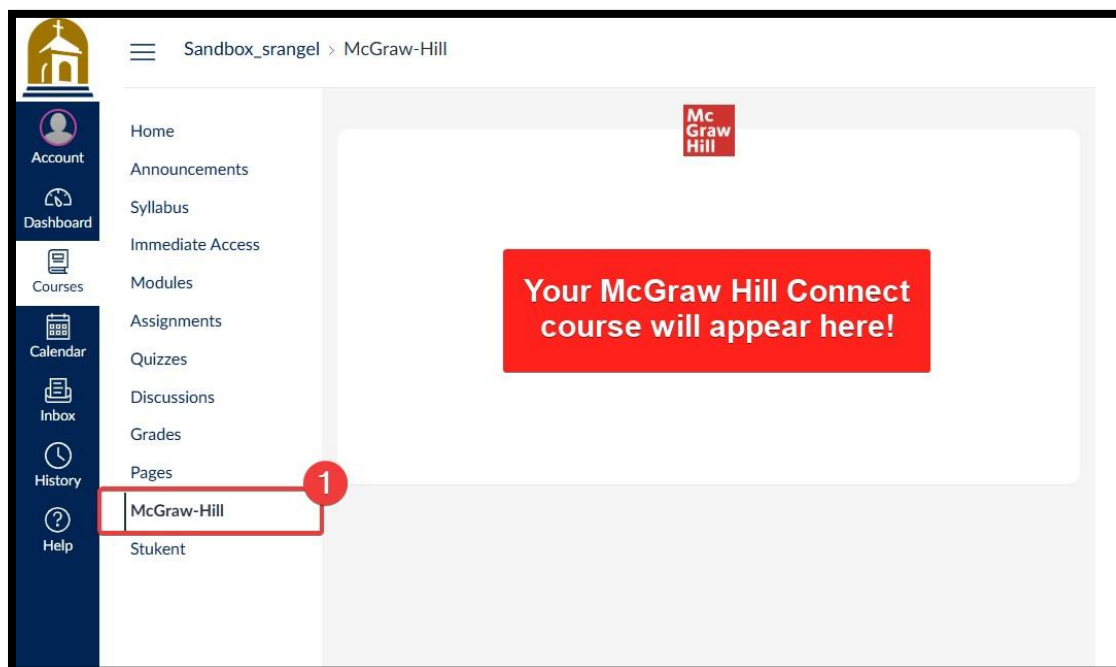
4. You will be pathed to the Cengage site, where you will be prompted to log into a Cengage account.

How To Access McGraw Hill Connect Courseware

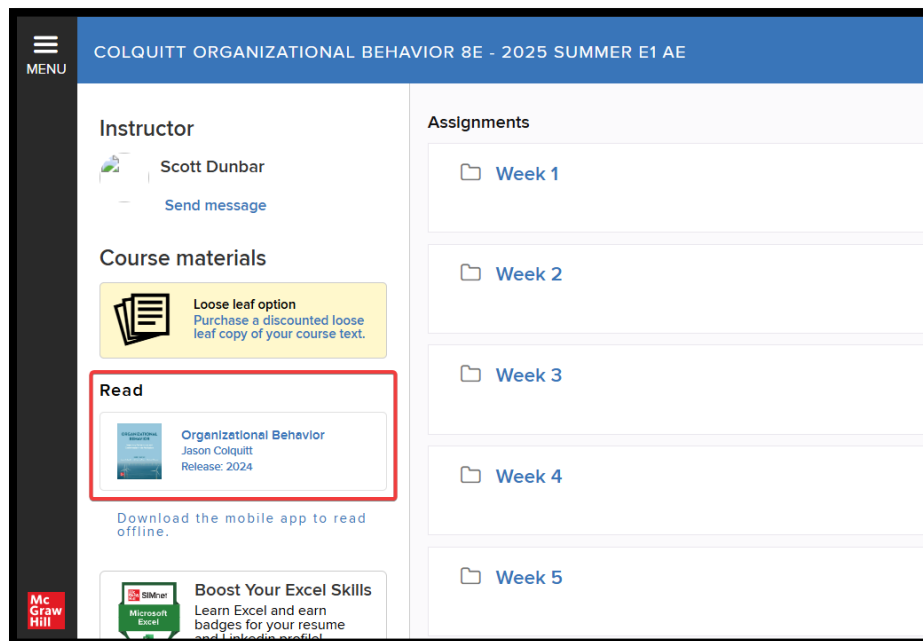
1. Sign onto **Canvas** and go to the course using McGraw Hill Connect courseware.



2. On the left-hand course menu, click → **McGraw Hill** to be pathed to your McGraw Hill Connect course.

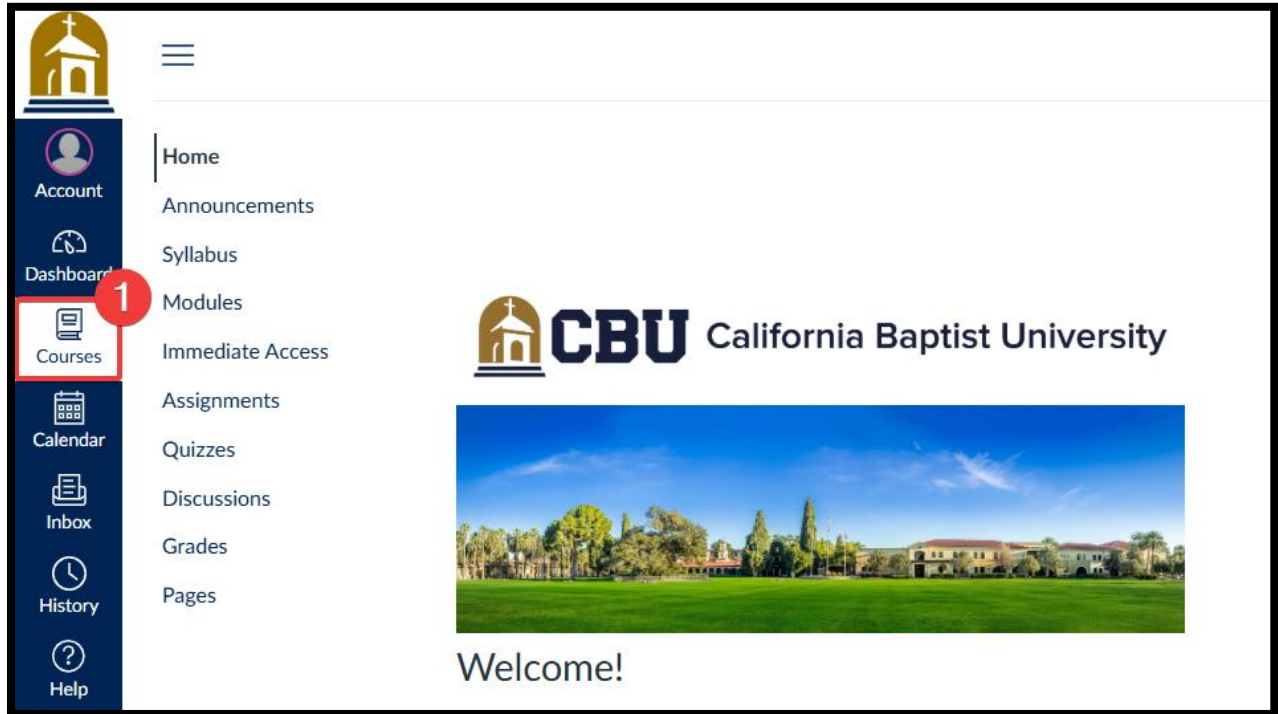


3. On the right-hand side, you will be pathed to the McGraw Hill site, where you will be prompted to log into a McGraw Hill Connect account.

4. Once logged in, you should be pathed to the McGraw Hill Connect course, where you can access both the eTextbook and the assignments below.

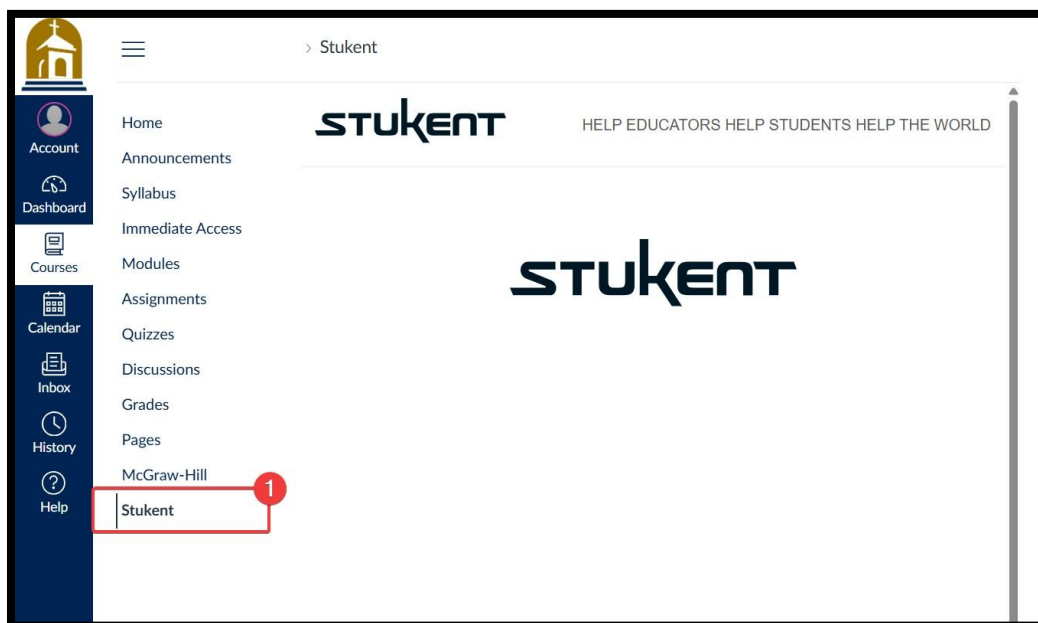


How To Access Stukent Courseware
